Instructor Anna Cooková lived in the Czech Republic from 1994-2002. She returned to the Czech Republic in 2008-2009 to interpret for the delegation from Rice Lake, WI to their Sister-City, Žamberk and has been offering Community Courses in Czech Language & Culture in Czech-American Communities since her return in 2009. In 2012 she began teaching online, and in 2013 she was awarded a grant to attend Methodologies of Teaching the Czech Language course in Prague by the Czech Government. She was a Registered Court Interpreter with the State of Illinois Courts from 2015-2020. In 2017 she was a part of the Two Rivers, WI Sister-City delegation to Domažlice, Czech Republic, served as President of Wisconsin Czechs, Inc. from 2017-2020 and currently volunteers as 2nd Vice President of Sokol Milwaukee and as Education Director for the national American Sokol organization. She has been teaching and translating professionally since 2009, and enjoys raising their daughter to love all things Czech and to be bilingual in Czech and English.

Should anyone need to miss a class we would try to review during the next class, or they may need to set up a separate private lesson to get caught up, which is a separate charge. The instructor does not recommend skipping material as everything tends to build on itself. Registrations are non-refundable, but transferable. Additional fees may apply.
